

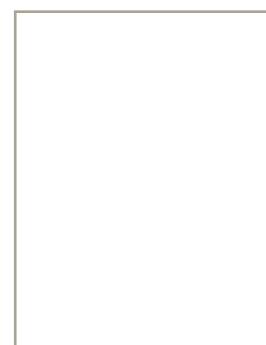

# EXECUTIVE MASTER IN IT GOVERNANCE - 2009

## OPTIONAL MODULES

Besides the four core-modules (C1-C2-C3-C4), three optional modules - to select from the following list - are required for participants seeking to obtain the "Executive Master in IT Governance". The degree is delivered after attendance of the four core modules, the three optional modules (with a min. course-participation of 70%) and after passing the exam and completing a dissertation.

### SELECTION OF 3 OPTIONAL MODULES:

**M1 - Applications and e-Business Management** (January-April 2009)

Basic principles for the development of Applications and e-Business systems. This module addresses security issues, implementation methodologies, and presentation of usual technical platforms.

**M2 - IT Legislations and IT Forensics** (April-June 2009)

Overview of e-Business and IT related laws, and IT Forensics practice and tools.

**M3 - IT Resources and Service Management: ITIL** (September-December 2009)

Workshop based on the de facto standard ITIL (IT Infrastructure Library). The course focuses on ITIL v2 and ITIL v3 essentials.

**G2 - IT Process Management** (April-June 2009)

Governance, Control and Audit of IT and related technology (CobiT).

**A2 – Enterprise Architecture and Risk** (April-June 2009)

ERP Implementation Review, Application Controls and Audit of Data. This module also focuses on Enterprise Architecture (Review and Audit aspects); Project Risk Management; Enterprise Risk Management – CobiT Risk.

**S3 - Information Security Management and Standards** (September-December 2009)

Based on the topics of the common body of knowledge required for CISM (Certified Information Security Manager). The five domains of knowledge are addressed by subject matter practitioners.
